

Qualifications for water and wastewater coatings and rehabilitation projects

Financial stability and general qualifiers

1. Current financial statements including profit and loss statement and balance sheet
2. W3 Transmittal of Wage and Tax Statement indicating wages and taxes paid by employer
3. Permanent name and address of business, number of employees and length of time in business under present name
4. Names of members of firm holding appropriate trade licenses, with license numbers / certificates
5. Licensed as a General Contractor in North Carolina with classifications:
 - a. Public Utilities (Water and Sewer) - Unlimited
 - b. Unclassified – Unlimited
6. Written statement from bonding company listing total and available bonding capacity
7. Copy of current Certificate of Insurance

Experience qualifiers

8. Bidder shall have AMPP Senior Certified Coatings Inspector and AMPP SSPC Concrete Coating Inspector on staff. Provide names, certifications, and numbers. AMPP, Association for Materials Protection and Performance is the merged entity formerly known as Society for Protective Coatings (SSPC) and National Association of Corrosion Engineers (NACE)
9. Bidder's superintendent shall have been responsible for or managed projects similar in size to this proposed project in the past 3 years in the US. Provide references and documentation about the superintendent's ability and qualifications to meet this requirement.
10. Five water and wastewater references within the last 5 years including contact name, address, phone, email, project name, contract amount, completion date, and other relevant information
11. Bidder shall be certified as an installer by manufacturer with a minimum of 5 years of experience and 100,000 square feet of product installation. Submit a statement from material manufacturer stating bidder is an approved applicator and has applied the minimum square feet of application.
12. Bidder shall provide a list of company owned equipment used to perform stated work.
13. Statement regarding % of work to be completed in-house and list of all sub contractors.
Consider requiring a minimum percentage of work to be completed with own forces. (i.e., no more than 20% will be subcontracted)
14. Bidder shall provide documentation on all subcontractors with same requirements as items 8-12

Safety record qualifiers

15. Affidavit stating whether or not any OSHA violations have occurred within past 3 years
16. Copy of safety program
17. Signed documentation of safety training by employees in areas of known safety hazards within the scope of this project.
